The following are updates for September 2021:

Dulles Airport in Virginia- Triaging of Patients: August 2021-current

AMPAA in collaboration with the Red Cross & Centers for Disease Controls (CDC) is assisting with the triaging of patients. All medical personnel can join in the efforts once flights resume from international bases. We are anticipating operations to continue in the next few weeks.

Quantico Base in Virginia- Medical Services: August 2021-current

AMPAA is working with the medical marines at the base in Quantico. If you are a U.S. citizen (no dual-citizens) and, licensed to practice in Virginia then contact us to volunteer at the safe haven. We are also accepting those for medical translation. The need for female Pashto speakers is great!

Global Telemedicine Project- Afghan Providers Needed: September 2021

AMPAA in collaboration with a military veteran group, MinorityVet, will begin a telemedicine program. Please see the flyer attached. The electronic medical record (EMR) will be Amwell. We will first begin with refugees in Qatar and Afghanistan then progress to other sites (Germany). An orientation session will be held which will address questions. Please stay tuned.

Mental Health Initiative- Need for all Mental Health Professionals: September 2021

Mental health providers (psychiatrists, psychologists, mental health counselors, etc) are being called upon at this time. Their services will be needed either in person or via telemedicine throughout the nation. Several organizations have reached out to us.

Medical Translation- Need for Medical Translators: September 2021

The need is great for strong medical translation. We are looking for those to assist many efforts either in person or virtually. AMPAA can also provide training for those interested.

Specialty Care- Need for OB/Gyn, Pediatricians, & Dentists: September 2021
